Contoh	
Langsung	Tak langsung
He said, "I buy a book."	He said (that) he bought a book
He said, "I am buying a book."	He said (that) he was buying a book
He said, "I bought a book."	He said (that) he had bought a book
He said, "I have bought a book."	He said (that) he had bought a book
He said, "I am going to buy a book."	He said (that) he was going to buy a book
He said, "I have to buy a book."	He said (that) he had to buy a book
He said, "I may buy a book."	He said (that) he might buy a book
He said, "I can buy a book."	He said (that) he could buy a book
He said, "I will buy a book."	He said (that) he would buy a book
He said, "I should buy a book."	He said (that) he should buy a book
He said, "I ought to buy a book."	He said (that) he ought to buy a book

### II. PENGGUNAAN TELL, ASK, IF, WETHER, DAN KALIAMAT TANYA

Contoh	
Langsung	Tak langsung
He said to me, "I will buy a book."	He <b>told me</b> that he would buy a book.
He said to me, "Do you buy a book?"	He <b>asked me if</b> I bought a book. He <b>asked me wether</b> I bought a book.
He said to me, "Where do you buy a book?"	He asked me <b>where</b> I bought a book.
He said to me, "Please buy a book for me."	He asked me <b>to buy</b> him a book.
He said to me, "Would you come to my house?"	He invited me <b>to come</b> to his house.
He said to me, "You'd better call a doctor."	He suggested me to call a doctor.
